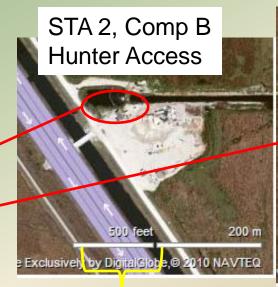

- Currently at other STAs
  - Bike and Hike
    - Designated open areas of the STA
  - Fishing exterior canals
  - Bird watching
  - Hunting
  - Existing
    - Comp B & C FWC managed hunting
    - Comp C Audubon bird watching tours



### **STA Activities – Conceptual Plans**



- Public Access Within STA
  - After Access Site Built
    - Define areas and times open
    - Other STAs –Fri., Sat., Sun., Mon. daylight hours
    - Bike, hike, bird watching
  - Board Approval Required
  - Rule 40E-7 Then Applies

## STA Activities – Conceptual Plans



- FWC Managed Hunting
  - Waterfowl when habitat is SAV
    - 2012 STA 2 Cell 4
  - Alligator along edges of cells with open water
    - 2012 STA 2 Cell 4
  - Hog would be first time in an STA
    - If necessary to control feral hog populations
    - Dryer western portions of STA5/6, Comp C
