

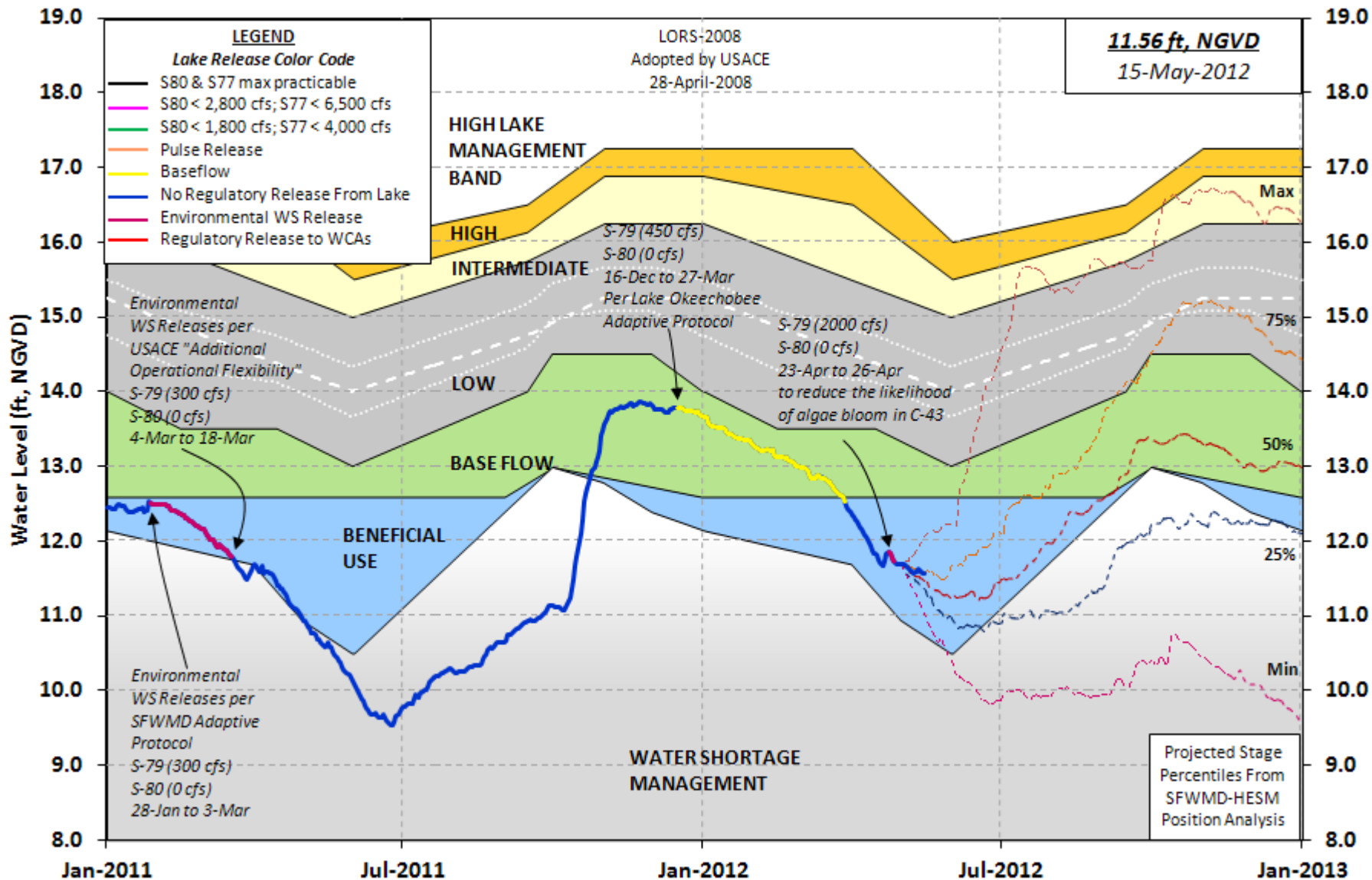

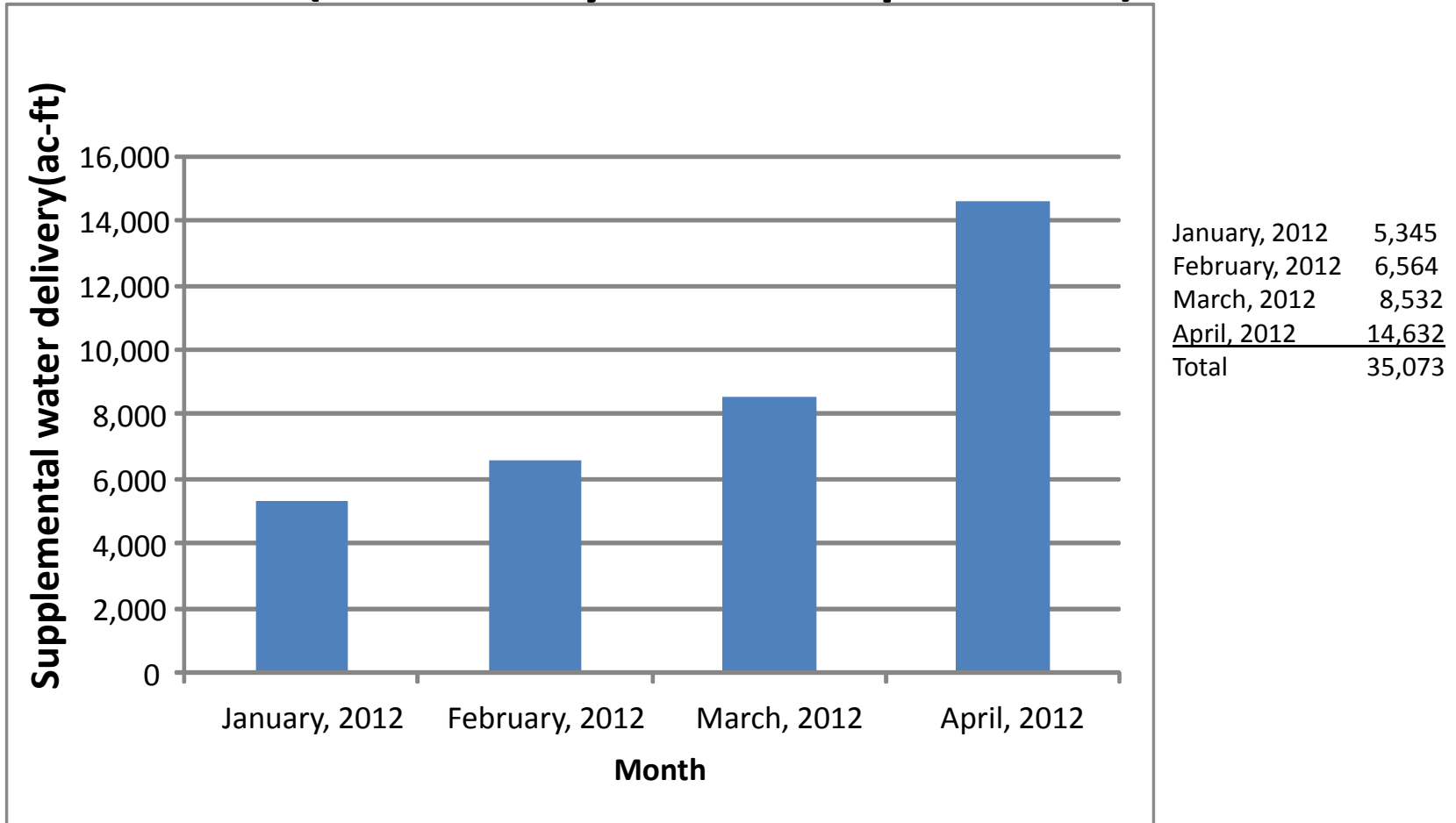
# Lake Okeechobee Water Level History and Projected Stages



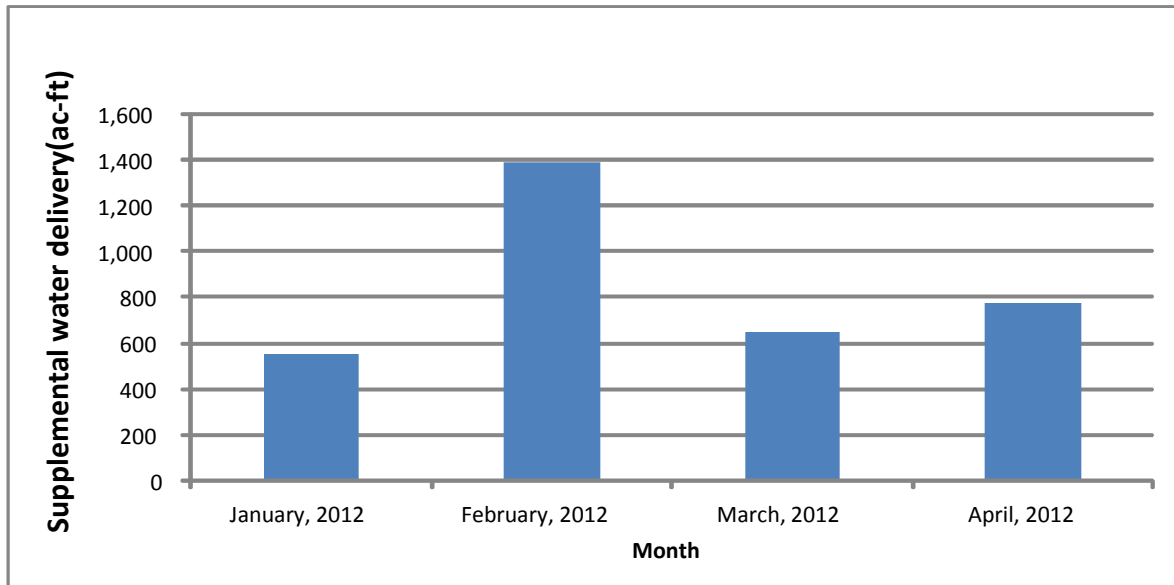
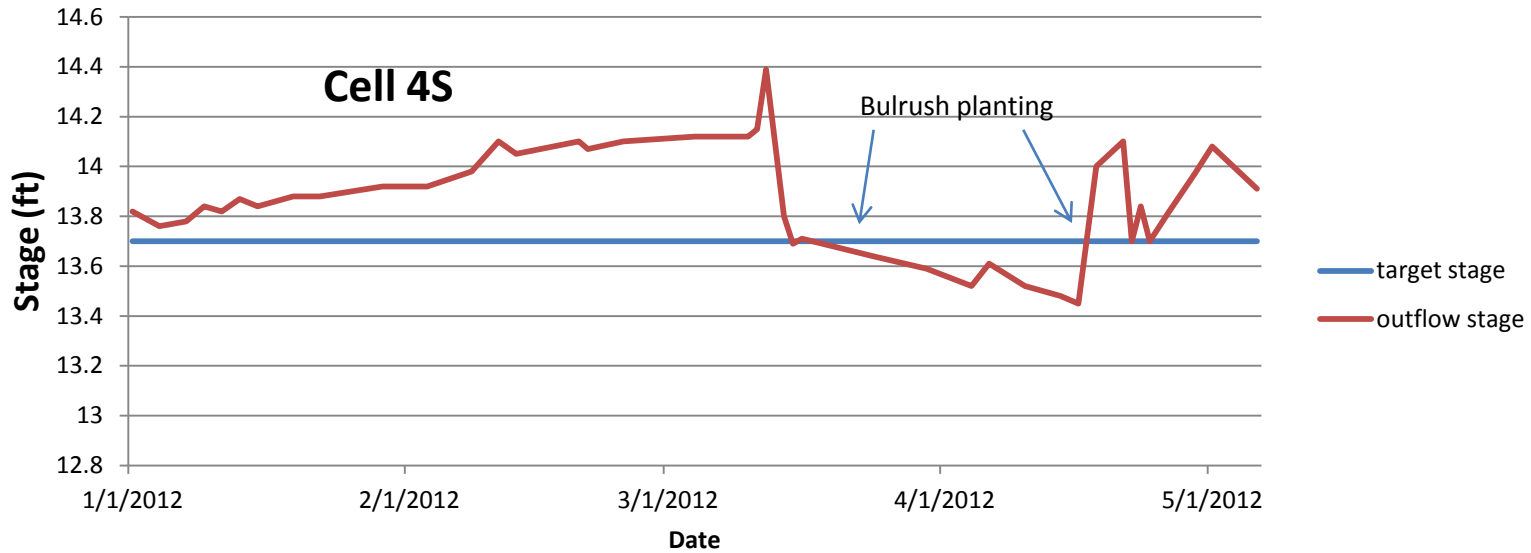
# 2011-2012 Dry Season

- October rains raised Lake Okeechobee levels. Up to 12 inches in Kissimmee Valley
- November through January were the lowest rainfall months on record
- February and March below average
- April: an inch above 2.39 inch average
- Wet season started in early May. Last year was late June.

# Supplemental Water Delivered to STAs During 2012 Dry Season (January 17 – April 18)

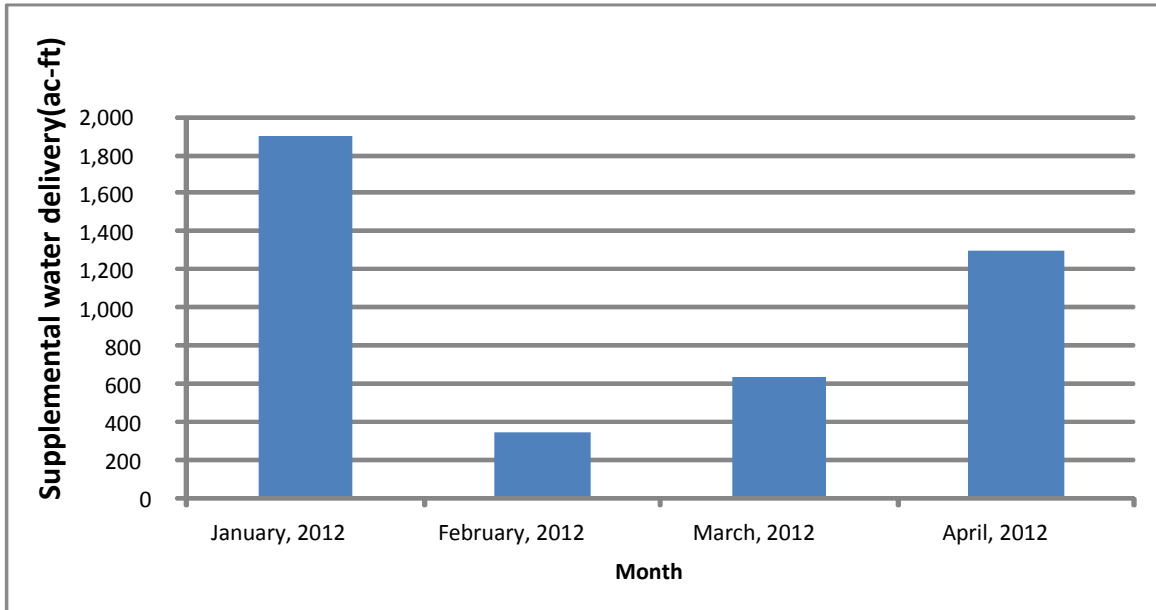
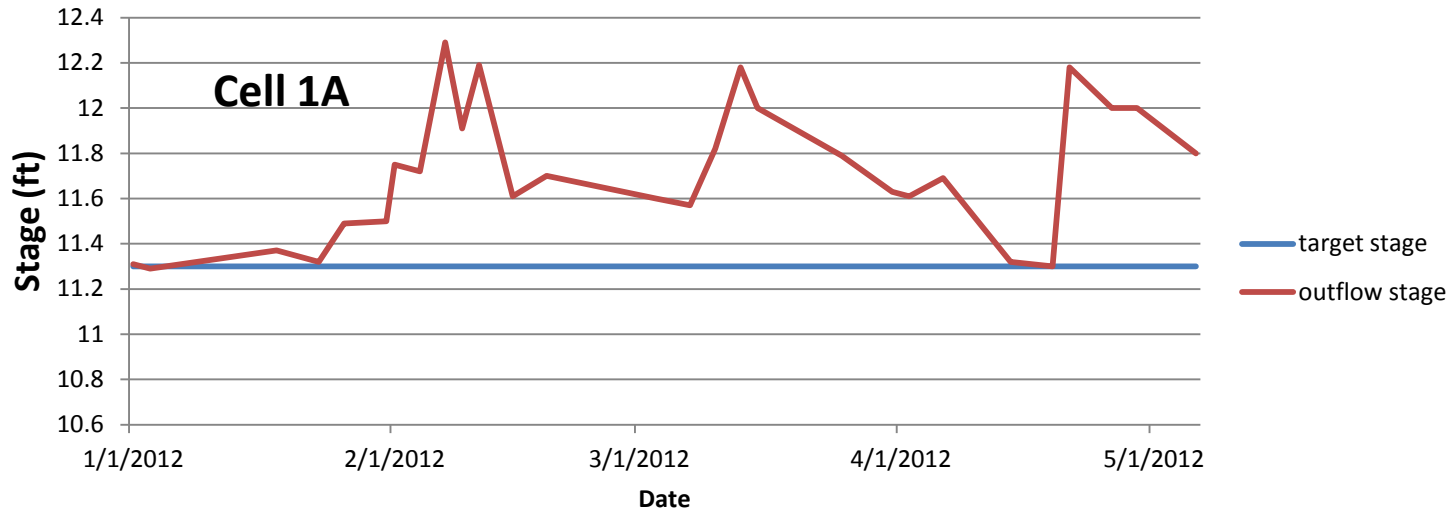
