


New Inflow Structure to STA-1W Cell 2










Stormwater Treatment Area-3/4 Captures Top Honor

The South Florida Water Management District's Stormwater Treatment Area 3/4 was awarded the "Grand Conceptor Award" – the nation's most prestigious award for innovative engineering – by the American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC) at award ceremonies held in Washington, D.C. April 11, 2005.
