

# Mickelson Residence

- **Palm Beach County**
- **Adjacent to the Wellington Basin B, Section 24 Impoundment.**
- **Total project area is 60 acres.**
- **Applicant previously conducted unauthorized work on the site and entered into a Consent Agreement on February 15, 2007. In addition to payment of civil penalties and costs, applicant was required to acquire an ERP for the site.**



# Mickelson Residence

- Applicant is requesting authorization to construct and operate an equestrian/residential facility (residence/ shop/ stable facility) which includes a surface water management system consisting of two lakes.
- The project will ultimately discharge to an existing canal located within the Pine Tree Water Control District.



## Mickelson Residence

- **Project surface water management system provides an additional 50% water quality treatment.**
- **Permit special condition requires submittal of an Animal Waste Management Plan on handling of waste material.**



## Mickelson Residence

- **Regulation Staff has coordinated review of this project with the Section 24 impoundment project manager who has determined that this application is not inconsistent with the restoration goals of the CERP project.**



## Staff Recommendation:

**Staff recommends approval of an Environmental Resource Permit for Construction and operation of a surface water management system to serve a 60.0 acre residential/recreational project known as Mickelson Residence.**
