Purpose of Contract Services

- **Fulfill State and Federal legal requirements**
 - §106 National Historic Preservation Act
 - Chapter 267 Florida Historical Resources Act
 - Chapter 872 Offenses Concerning Graves
- **Fulfill federal requirements prior to USACE issuing a §404 Clean Water Act Permit as well as requirements of permits once issued**
- **Support multiple Everglades Restoration projects: CERP, Acceler8, LOFT, EFA and Northern Everglades**



RFP 1 – Cultural Resources Reconnaissance Surveys, Monitoring and Training Services

- **Fulfill permit requirements to train construction personnel**
- **Monitor construction activities to avoid damage to cultural resources**
- **Conduct reconnaissance surveys prior to land acquisition to determine potential for finding Cultural Resources eligible for the National Register of Historic Places**



RFP 2 – Comprehensive Archaeological/ Historical Surveys and Services

- **Complete Phase I, II or III Surveys to locate and determine eligibility of archaeological and historical resources for the National Register of Historic Places**
 - Research design, subsurface excavation and analysis and interpretation
 - Develop mitigation plan if restoration project adversely affects identified resources
 - Coordinate all surveys and mitigation with USACE, State Historic Preservation Office, Native American Tribes and Advisory Council on Historic Preservation
- **Consult with Native American Tribes on potential affects to eligible resources and fulfill request to avoid inundating ancestral burials**
