- **Palm Beach County**
- **Environmental Resource Permit (ERP) requested for construction and operation of a surface water management system serving an existing 40.17 acre nursery facility.**
- **Project is located adjacent to the boundary of the Palm Beach County Strazzulla Wetlands CERP project.**

- **Notice of Violation previously issued by the District for unauthorized works, including wetland impacts.**
- **Governing Board approved a Consent Agreement at its March 2007 meeting with resolution of enforcement requiring respondent to pay civil penalties, staff investigative costs, and obtaining required District permits (Environmental Resource and Water Use Permits).**
- **Respondent failed to obtain permits under agreed upon timelines and has entered into a second Consent Agreement.**

- Of the 40.17 acre project site, 28.8 acres will be the actual nursery facility and 10.95 acres (9.8 acres of wetland and 1.15 acres of upland buffer) will be preserved and placed under conservation easement.
- Water quality will be provided in existing swales and lake with ultimate discharge to Lake Worth Drainage District Canal S-9.

Staff from Environmental Resource Regulation have coordinated review of this project with the Palm Beach County Strazzulla Wetlands CERP Project Manager who has determined that this application is not incompatible with future restoration goals of the CERP project.



Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends authorization for construction and operation of a surface water management system to serve an existing 40.17 – acre wholesale nursery facility to be known as K & M Nursery.
