




# What is the Long-Term Plan?

- **State's blueprint for meeting the phosphorus water quality standard, Rule 62-302.540**
- **Includes Stormwater Treatment Area (STA) enhancements, monitoring, research, source controls, and accelerated recovery projects**
- **District and Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) can propose revisions to Long-Term Plan but only FDEP can approve Long-Term Plan revisions**

# Long-Term Plan Addresses Discharges from:

- STA-1W
- STA-2
- STA-3/4
- STA-5
- STA-6
- Acme Basin B
- North Springs Improvement District Basin
- North New River Canal Basin
- C-11W Basin
- C-11W Basin

# Long-Term Plan Revision Process

- **Revision process includes public involvement component**
  - **Discuss revisions at Long-Term Plan Public Communication Meetings and WRAC Meetings**
  - **District's Governing Board Accepts Proposed Revisions to Long-Term Plan**
  - **District submits request to FDEP for approval**
  - **FDEP approves within 30 days**
  - **Include summary of revisions in annual South Florida Environmental Report (SFER)**
- **As part of ongoing planning process for River of Grass projects, District will begin exploring options to include projects in the Long-Term Plan**
