

#### How To Get There STA 1E:

From Interstate-95: Travel about 18 miles west on S.R. 80/U.S. 441. It is the closest stormwater treatment area to urban Palm Beach County.

From the Florida Turnpike: Travel 11 miles west on S.R. 80/U.S. 441. The Public access site is on the south side of the road across a cement bridge where a left turn lane is provided. The area is open from sunrise to sunset on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays.

#### How To Get There STA 1W:

From West Palm Beach: Travel about 21 miles west on S.R. 80/U.S. 441 to the intersection of CR 880 and SR 80. Look for a flashing yellow light and a sign that says Welcome to Western Palm Beach County. Turn south on CR 880 and cross a green metal bridge continue south. The public access entrance is on C.R. 880, 2 miles beyond the bridge, look for brown recreation road signs.

From Belle Glade: Travel east on SR 80, about 18 miles to the intersection of CR 880 and SR 80. Look for a flashing yellow light. Turn south on CR 880 and cross a green metal bridge, continue south. The public access entrance is on C.R. 880, 2 miles beyond the bridge, look for brown recreation road signs.

The area is open from sunrise to sunset on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays except during hunting season ( Last weekend in September to November 15) when the area is closed to the public one day per weekend.

#### How To Get There STA 3/4:

About 14 miles north of Interstate-75, or 25 miles south of South Bay, on the west side of U.S. Hwy. 27. Look for the Palm Beach Broward County line and large overhead power lines that cross the road and go west along the paved L5 levee road. Look for brown recreation road signs.

#### Harold Campbell Public Use Facility:

Travel west, 5 miles on asphalt turn north into Harold A. Campbell site.

Open for motor boating in canals seven days a week sunup to sundown,  
Hiking and biking: open weekends Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays

To South East Corner Public Use Facility travel west about ½ mile turn north into site.  
Open for hiking and biking weekends Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays, sunup to sundown

#### How To Get There STA 5: (Open only for Tours See web site for schedule.)

From South Bay, travel west on U.S. Hwy. 27 about 13½ miles to C.R. 835 (Evercane Road). From Clewiston travel about 1 mile east to C.R. 835 (Evercane Road). Turn south on C.R. 835 and travel about 9½ miles to Blumberg Road intersection look for old cell tower just prior north, this turn is the second turn to the west in the road. Turn south east onto Blumberg Road and travel south about 9 miles to the unpaved STA turnoff road. Turn onto the unpaved road and travel about 2.5 miles to the entrance gate.
