# SOUTH FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT 

Resolution No. 2017-0208


#### Abstract

A Resolution of the Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District to implement Section 5 Specific Appropriation 1590C of the 2016 Florida Legislature General Appropriations Act for Grants and Aids to Local Governments and Nonstate Entities in the amount of $\$ 350,000$ in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund; and authorize the Executive Director or Designee to execute agreements at no cost to the District with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Contract Number 4600003613) and the City of Clewiston (Contract Number 4600003609); and authorize an amendment to the Adopted Fiscal Year 2016-2017 budget; providing an effective date.


WHEREAS, HB5001, the 2016 General Appropriations Act, Section 5 Specific Appropriation 1590C, the Florida Legislature appropriated nonrecurring funds of $\$ 350,000$, through Grants and Aids to Local Governments and Nonstate Entities, Fixed Capital Outlay from the General Revenue Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District (District) authorizes the Executive Director, or designee, to execute an agreement with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Department), at no cost to the District, contract number 4600003613; for the implementation of Specific Appropriation 1590C; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the District authorizes the Executive Director, or designee, to execute an agreement with the City of Clewiston, at no cost to the District, contract number 4600003609, for the engineering and design of the C-21 Bridge Canal Crossing Planning Project at S-169, a component of the District's 50 -year capital improvement plan; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the District on September 20, 2016 adopted Resolution No. 2016-0928 "Adopting the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017"; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the District authorizes an amendment to the Adopted Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Budget to recognize $\$ 350,000$ of Intergovernmental Revenue from the Department for Specific Appropriation 1590C; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 373.536(4) Florida Statutes, if the district receives unanticipated funds after the adoption of the final budget, the final budget may be amended, following review and approval by the Executive Office of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 373.536(4) Florida Statutes, the notice of intention to amend was published in the notice of the Governing Board meeting at which the Budget Amendment will be considered; and

WHEREAS, implementation of this budget amendment is contingent upon approval by the Executive Office of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, consistent with specific appropriation 1590C language and in accordance with the procedures set forth in the executed agreements, the Department shall disburse to the District $\$ 350,000$ of General Revenue Fund monies.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SOUTH FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT:

Section 1. The Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District hereby approves implementing HB5001, for the Florida Legislature, the 2016 General Appropriations Act, Section 5 Specific Appropriation 1590C, nonrecurring funds of $\$ 350,000$, through Grants and Aids to Local Governments and Nonstate Entities, Fixed Capital Outlay from the General Revenue Fund.

Section 2. The Executive Director of the District, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the City of Clewiston, at no cost to the District, to implement Specific Appropriation 1590C.

Section 3. The Executive Director of the District, or designee, is hereby authorized to request the Department disburse $\$ 350,000$ to the District to implement Specific Appropriation 1590C.

Section 4. Funds disbursed from the Department to the District to implement Specific Appropriation 1590C shall be subject to the requirements of the Section 215.97 Florida Statutes (The Florida Single Audit Act) and Section 216.181(16)(b), Florida Statutes.

Section 5. The Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District hereby approves amending the Adopted Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Budget as presented in Exhibit " $A$ ", which is attached hereto and made part hereof.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
