1. Opening Remarks – Damon Meiers

Mr. Meiers opened the meeting at about 9:05 a.m. There was a brief discussion on the Statewide Stormwater Rule Workshop

2. Discussion on TMDL and NNC

Kevin Carter presented an overview of NNC and handed out and reviewed summary of the District's comments to EPA. A link will be sent out to the Canal Science

Inventory report. Mr. Carter also described that the ERC approved a designated use change to add a Class III limited use. This is the first step for formal adoption including approval by EPA. We will also send out a link to EPA's Public Comment page.

Mr. Carter then presented an overview of TMDL process and local issues

- C-51 West Basin is listed as impaired for TP & TN
- C-51 West Basin is listed as impaired for DO

Mr. Wertepny handed out a letter from DEP changing/correcting a WBID that intersected the connection between the C-51 East and the Lake Worth Lagoon WBIDs.

There was also a discussion of Bob Brown's memo and how it relates to the Impaired Waters listing for C-51 East Basin.

3. Update on FEMA Mapping

Ken Todd discussed background and update of Palm Beach County FEMA FIRM issues. Ken handed out a scheduled for the mapping from the FEMA website.

Possible future topics include discussion of "Authorization of Dry Season Water Conservation Measures" and a status report on Natural Systems and Consumptive Use.
