
- Governor's Executive Order 19-12

Why revise Chapter 40E-61, F.A.C.


2016 Northern Everglades and Estuaries Protection Program (NEEPP) requires:

- Amendments to 40E-61, F.A.C., for Lake Okeechobee Watershed
- New rules for Caloosahatchee and St. Lucie River Watersheds
- Consistency with NEEPP and 403.067, F.S.
- A monitoring program for Non-point Source dischargers required to monitor
- Research and Water Quality Monitoring Program



40E-61 Draft Concept

- Establish monitoring to
 - Represent nutrient levels in contributing areas
 - Provide data for research and to evaluate effectiveness of Nutrient Reduction Technologies
 - Provide requirements for monitoring in lieu of BMP's
- Establish methods to evaluate and assess data to track progress
- Take action where data shows more reduction is needed
