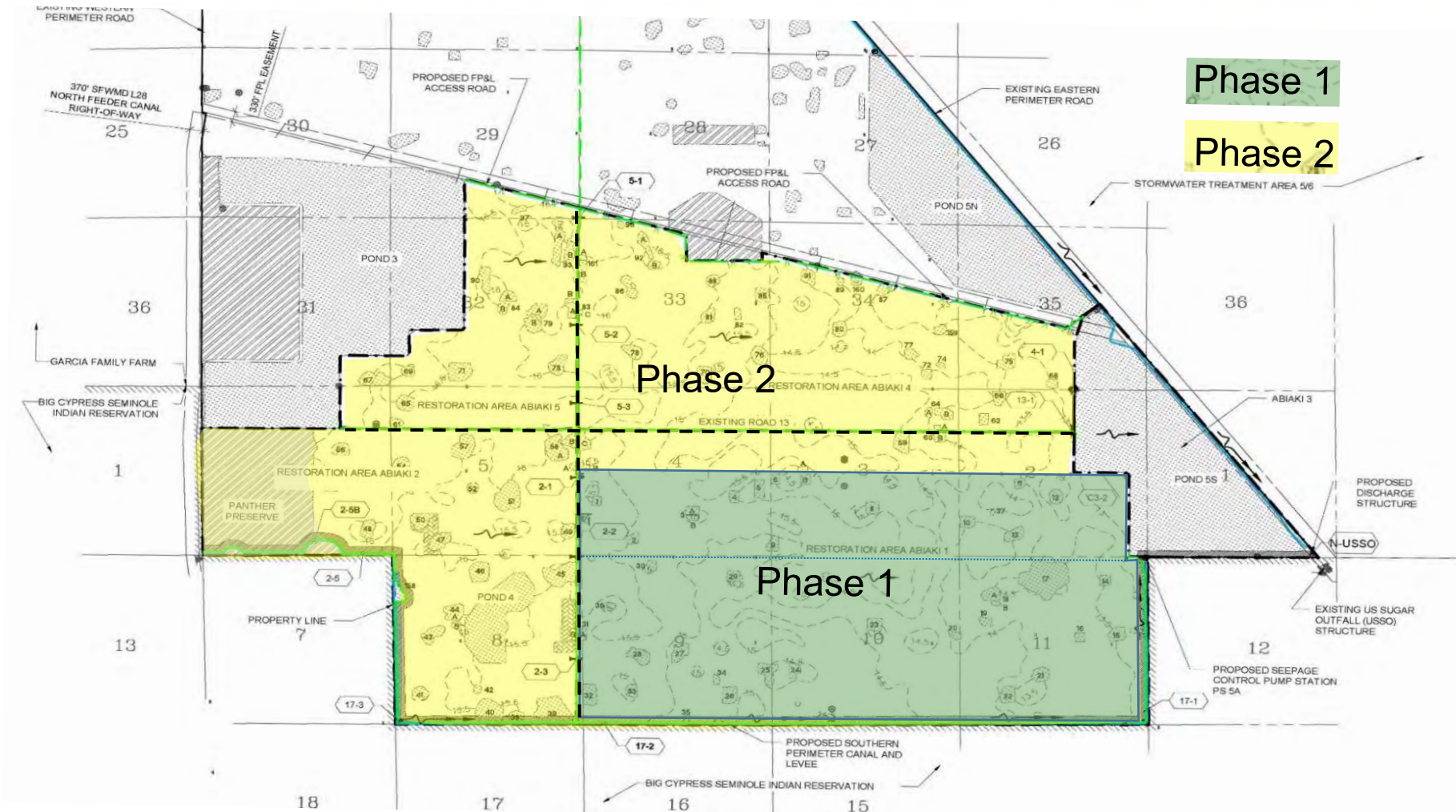

- 7,800 acre restoration footprint
- Removal of citrus farm planting beds, irrigation systems and drainage piping
- Backfill of citrus farm drainage canals
- New seepage management system with pump station
- New gravity water control structures
- New berms with access roads
