


Project Timeline Project Planning: 2019-2021


- **>** 2019
 - September: SFWMD and FDEP begin a public exploration of a project to address Lake Okeechobee pollution
- **>** 2020
 - January: A conceptual project is placed in the Lake Okeechobee BMAP Update to address 3 priority basins
 - October: Grant funding from FDEP is made available for the project
- **>** 2021
 - March: SFWMD solicits proposals to design, construct, and operate the Lower Kissimmee Basin Stormwater Treatment Project
 - April: SFWMD receives proposals from 2 respondents: Ecosystem Investment Partners (EIP) and Resource Environmental Solutions (RES)

Lake Okeechobee Water Quality






Lake Okeechobee Watershed Water Quality

- Monitoring results show more TP reductions are needed north of Lake Okeechobee
- Highest TP concentrations consistently come from Taylor Creek / Nubbin Slough subwatershed






