



F. Groundwater Allocation in the Central Florida Coordination Area (CFCA) –

1. Overall Intent:

The Central Florida Coordination Area (“CFCA”) is located within portions of three water management districts and includes Polk, Orange, Osceola and Seminole Counties, and southern Lake County. Within the South Florida Water Management District, the CFCA is the area delineated in Figure 3-4. As shown in Figure 3-4, the boundary for the portion of the CFCA located within this District is that portion of the south line of Polk County and the South line of Osceola County as said county boundaries are described in Sections 7.53 and 7.49, F.S., respectively, lying within the boundaries of the South Florida Water Management District as described in Subsection 373.069(2)(e), F.S.
