

DuPuis Management Area Touring and Bicycling

DuPuis is open for general public recreational use 24 hours a day — except on scheduled hunt dates. Overnight Camping is available in designated campsites.

There are four public entrances into DuPuis. Vehicles may access the property through the Gate 1 entrance. There is no fee for people to enjoy this natural beauty.

“Jim Lake Grade” to “DuPuis Grade” extends 7 1/2 miles to the fishing pier at the end of the DuPuis Grade. The intersection where Jim Lake Grade meets with DuPuis Grade is about 3 miles from the Gate 1 entrance. Picnicking areas are available through the Gate 1 entrance as well as at the Nature Center. There is a footbridge to a small island on the corner of Jim Lake and DuPuis grades with a picnic table under the oaks and views of a pond. A cypress boardwalk with an overlook is located near the end of the DuPuis Grade.

Bicycling is permitted on all named and numbered roads. Bicycles are not permitted on hiking or horse trails. A biking trail is located at the Gate 2 hiking trail entrance (see map on next page).

All trash must be packed out upon your departure.
