Florida Water Star (www.floridawaterstar.com) is a water conservation recognition program for residential properties sponsored by the state's three largest water management districts. This two-day training is the first step towards becoming a **Florida Water Star Residential Certifier**. The workshop will describe the program criteria; the role and responsibilities of the certifier; and process for completing the certifier training. Following a day of classroom instruction, certifier trainees will enjoy hands-on field training on the Florida Water Star inspection process. The Florida Water Star Certifier Exam will be administered on Friday, June 17, for interested participants. Overall, this workshop provides the foundation for the prospective certifier to become proficient in residential water conservation principles, inspection protocol, reporting requirements, and other essential knowledge bases.

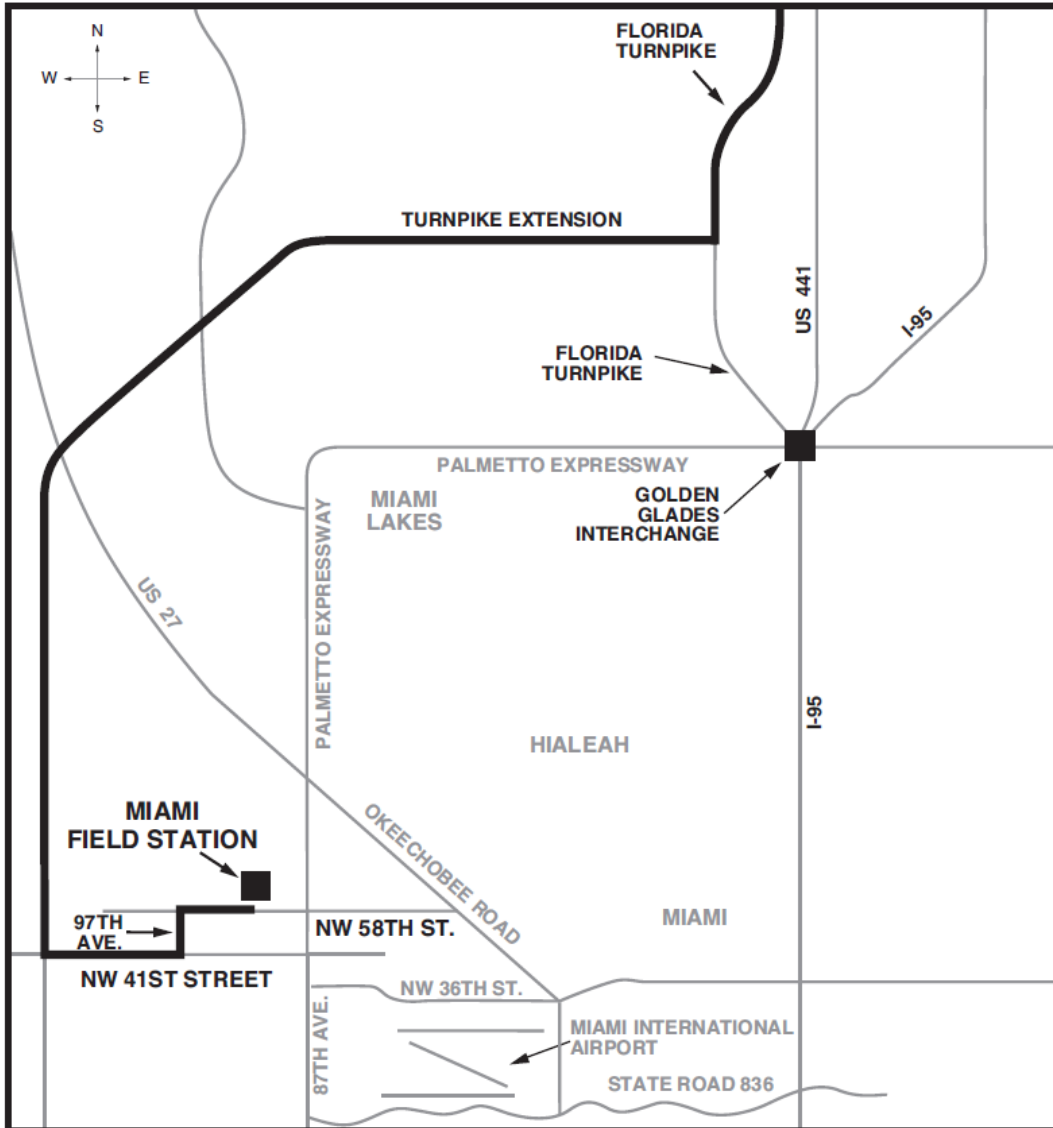

Certifiers in other programs, such as LEED or Energy Star, may find this training especially useful and could soon be offering water use evaluations and **Florida Water Star Certifications** as a value-added benefit to their customers.
