 - a) Corrections included:

Terrie Bates requested that the questions raised in the field be documented in the minutes. These included the requirement of the existing ACOE permit to US Sugar relative to the panther biological opinion, District experience with carrying out similar types of restoration projects at this scale, adequacy of the proposed planting plan, and the provision for funding long term management of the restored site.

- 5. Financial Approval of Invoices for L-31N Seepage Barrier Project Marjorie Moore Marjorie reviewed the following invoices for acceptance:

- 6. Overview of Wetland Rapid Assessment Procedure (WRAP) Scoring Methodology Boyd Gunsalus
- a) Boyd presented an overview of the WRAP scoring methodology and its value as a predictive habitat evaluation index. He also reviewed the basis for the six WRAP variables and the scoring tabulation process. Discussion ensued regarding appropriateness of a reference wetland versus a hypothetical optimal wetland for each of the representative habitat types.
- 7. Review of Representative C-139 Annex Polygons and WRAP Scoring Ron Peekstok
- a) Ron discussed several of the representative polygons in depth including the cultivated areas, and undeveloped areas. He provided the rationale for his scoring and answered questions

related to the scoring basis. There was also discussion on the optimal versus sub-optimal

hydrology and its impact on the representative polygons.
