Dear Chairman Buermann:

I'm sure you are well aware of the February 17 memo from subject consultant that helped produce the Palm Beach Post article pasted below.

Nothing in the article surprises me, but one thing raises my red flag to the utmost. That is the idea that if cutbacks are needed O&M should be one of the key targets. Excuse me, but such a proposal has obviously been suggested by someone who hasn't a clue about what could be at stake in terms of, for starters, public safety and welfare.

The vast majority of C&SF Project facilities are now well beyond their 50-year design life and, while some progress has been made over the last several years in catching up with major repair needs, the vast majority of such refurbishment and upgrade work is still out in front of the District. To abandoned or significantly curtail this capital program would be worse than foolish. Please speak up in opposition to anything that would affect this program in a significant way.

As to cuts in the operating areas of O&M, the District needs to be very cautious about cutting back on personnel, fuel, parts and fittings, or any other aspect of what it takes to operate and maintain one of the largest public works projects in the nation.
