Conversion to Operation Phase and Transfer to Operating Entity

"Conversion Transfers"

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Operating Entity

The entity responsible for the long-term maintenance and function of a surface water management system.





Purpose of Review

To ensure that the operating entity

has the necessary legal

authority and responsibility

to maintain the

surface water management system.



- A permit does NOT automatically enter operation phase when construction is deemed complete.
- A conversion transfer must be requested.
- The designated operating entity must meet District requirements.



- The original permittee remains responsible until the conversion transfer is finalized.
- A request for conversion transfer (Form 0920) signed by the operating entity MUST be received for the transfer to be finalized, even if the developer submits all óther required documentation.

Permit Special Condition

- Specifies the District-approved operating entity for the surface water management system.
- Includes submittal deadlines.





Form 0920

- Official request for conversion transfer of the permit.
- Acceptance of the permit's conditions and requirements.



 Signed by the entity RECEIVING the permit.

Ownership / Easements

- Plat Dedications outline easements and state maintenance obligations
- Deed
- Recorded Easements



Operating Agreements



Permit Compliance

- Engineering:
 - Certification accepted by SFWMD staff
- Environmental:
 - Mitigation requirements fulfilled
 - Monitoring reports up-to-date





<u>Permittee</u>

- Stand-alone
- No conversion transfer required converted to operation phase upon acceptance of engineering certification
- Permit requires ownership transfer upon sale of property because permit does NOT run with the land.



Property Owners Association

- Signature authority = board member
- Declaration of Covenants,
 Restrictions and Easements,
 including Articles of Incorporation
- Affidavit Form #1351



Community Development District

- Signature authority = CDD supervisor or Board member
- Ordinance establishing the CDD pursuant to Chapter 190, F.S.



Multipurpose Special Taxing Unit

- Ordinance establishing the MSTU pursuant to county or city code
- Special Taxing Units do NOT cover surface water management systems





<u>Government</u>

- County
- Municipality
- Local 298 District





Engineering certification is accepted but the conversion transfer is not requested.

- Reminder within certification acceptance letters
- Convert/transfer applications as they are certified rather than waiting for certification of entire permit



Entity requesting conversion transfer differs from permitted operating entity.

- Submit recorded documentation supporting actual operating entity
- Request letter modification to change operating entity

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Multiple operating entities with split operational functions.

- Submit a conversion transfer request for each entity
- Each entity must meet District requirements
- Operating agreement



Association documents NOT satisfactory according to Section 9, Basis of Review.

- Amendment required
- Recorded Notice of Permit



Golf Course/Residential Communities

- Golf course as member of association
- Operating agreements between parties
- Cross-easements



Permit Transfer At Change of Ownership

"Ownership Transfers"

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Limiting/General Condition

- Permittee required to notify SFWMD within 30 days of transfer or conveyance of property (Rule 40E-1.6105)
- Permittee remains responsible for the permit until the permit transfer is completed (Rule 40E-1.6107)
- Conditions under which a permit transfer will be given by SFWMD are also provided under Rule 40E-1.6107



Importance of Transfer for Seller

- Permits are not transferred/conveyed with the deed. Separate action is required.
- Permittee remains liable/responsible for the permit until the permit transfer is completed.
- Permittee is responsible for notifying SFWMD of sale of property.
 - SFWMD notifies the new owner that they must transfer the permit.



Importance of Transfer for Buyer

- Rule 40E-4.041 Permits Required
 - The new owner is constructing and/or operating a system without a permit until the permit transfer is completed.
 - Applicable even if the new owner changes nothing in the plans.



- Proof of ownership for entire permitted area
- Application Form 0483
 - Signed by owner or authorized agent
 - Letter of authorization for agent
- Processing fee(s):
 - \$675 for ERP/SWM, \$300 for WU

When is an ownership transfer NOT appropriate?

- Permit is ready to be converted/ transferred to the operating entity
- Permit has expired (transfers do not extend the permit)
- Any change to the permit is proposed
- Applicant owns less than the originally permitted project area

Original permitted area purchased





A few last thoughts...
