

#### **Water Reuse**

- Reusing 70 MGD or 83% of treated wastewater
- Expansion of systems under way
- Reclaimed water ASR being developed
- Waiting lists for reclaimed water



#### **Brackish Water Sources**

- 15 Brackish Water Reverse Osmosis Facilities
- 87 MGD of existing capacity
- **83 MGD proposed next 20 years**



# Alternative Water Supply Projects

- 4 years of AWS Program
- 81 Alternative Water Supply Projects funded to date
- -78 million gallons of new water per day
- FY 2006-09 Funding \$49 Million




#### **ASR in Collier County**

- 18 ASR wells constructed
- 17 proposed ASR wells next20 years
- Supply Sources
  - Partially treated surface water
  - Drinking water
  - Reclaimed water







#### **Conservation**

# Future of AWS in Collier County

#### **CITY OF NAPLES**

- Develop an additional source of water up to 5 MGD
- Reduce consumption of potable water from 270 gallons per capita per day to below 200
- Conserve existing potable water supply from Lower Tamiami Aquifer
- Reduce reliance on expanded water treatment facilities
- Meet conditions of renewed water use permit, 100% reclaimed status



## Future of AWS in Collier County

- Four ASR wells over the next 5 years to allow recovery of 4 MGD to supplement the irrigation system.
- Expand supplemental water supply at a minimum of 5 MGD from Golden Gate Canal (GGC)
- Transfer GGC water to Riverside Circle for storage and/or distribution to irrigation system





# Future of AWS in Collier County

Water Booster Pump Station

Install pond liner at North County Water Reclamation Facility to increased storage of irrigation quality water
