Kissimmee River Navigation Lock to Close for Repairs

S-65A lock upgrade will help ensure years of service

West Palm Beach, FL — The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) plans to close the S-65A navigation lock to replace hardware needed to operate the gates.

The navigation lock will close for this work on August 15. It is expected to resume service on September 7.

The S-65A lock is located on the Kissimmee River about 11 miles south of State Road 60 and Lake Kissimmee.
