Lake Alligator Boat Ramp to temporarily close

WHAT: The Lake Alligator Boat Ramp, also known as the C-Gate Ramp, located

off Hickory Tree Road, will be closed while maintenance is performed on

the road leading to the ramp.

The work includes replacing old culverts and extending the service life of

the access road and will be completed in coordination with Osceola

County, which maintains the boat ramp.

Public access to Lake Alligator is also available at the Alligator Lakeside

Inn, located at 6264 E Irlo Bronson Memorial Hwy, St. Cloud. The

Lakeside Inn ramp is private and has an access fee.
