Lake Okeechobee Navigation Lock Closes for Emergency Repairs Crews are working to fix the manatee protection system

WHAT: To ensure protection of the endangered West Indian manatee, South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) staff is working to repair the manatee protection system at the S-135 Navigation Lock near the J&S Fish Camp north of the St. Lucie Canal.

The lock was closed today, and boaters may use the G-36 Navigation Lock as an alternative route.
