2015 Lobbyist Registration Forms Now Online at SFWMD *The public can access list of registered lobbyists in online database*

WHAT: The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) posted on its website the 2015 registration forms and FAQs for the lobbyist registration process. Lobbyists currently registered with the District must fill out and submit the forms to renew their registration for 2015.

All lobbyists must submit a registration form and principal's authorization before talking with an SFWMD official or employee on behalf of the firms, corporations or groups they are paid to represent. Registration expires annually on December 31 and may be renewed at the end of each calendar year. The District is not charging a fee to register or renew.
