Lake Okeechobee Navigation Lock Returns to Service

Manatee detection system repairs completed

WHAT: The S-135 Navigation Lock near J&S Park north of the St. Lucie Canal was

returned to service this morning after South Florida Water Management

District (SFWMD) staff completed emergency repairs to the lock's

manatee detection system. The detection system protects the endangered West Indian manatees from being injured or killed in the navigation lock.

WHEN: The navigation lock returned to service at 5:30 a.m. today. The lock

operator will resume the normal schedule for this time of year: 5:30 a.m. to

8:30 p.m.
