SFWMD Sends Pumps to Assist West Coast Flooding Response District personnel are also on standby if needed

WHAT: Following the Governor's State of Emergency declaration because of flooding on Florida's west coast, the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) sent four pumps Friday morning to support the emergency response effort.

The portable pumps may be used to help direct flood waters away from impacted areas.

SFWMD field crews are also ready to deploy if needed to areas in the five counties impacted: Dixie, Hillsborough, Pasco, Pinellas and Taylor. All counties are outside SFWMD boundaries.
