The Henry Creek boat lock will close for about two months during the work

- **WHAT:** The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) will perform a major gate overhaul at the Henry Creek (G-36) boat lock on Lake Okeechobee to ensure its continued operation.
- WHEN: The lock will close October 26 and is scheduled to reopen January 7, 2016.
- **WHERE:** The Henry Creek (G-36) Lock at the northeast corner of Lake Okeechobee in Okeechobee County
