SUBJECT: National Research Council report on Everglades restoration progress

The National Research Council's Committee on Independent Scientific Review of Everglades Restoration Progress today issued its third biennial review of progress made by the Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Plan (CERP). CERP is a 50-50 partnership between the State of Florida and the federal government for restoring, protecting and preserving the water resources of central and southern Florida.
