


Data Sources: Cover types were digitized in AutoCad from Miami-Dade County 1:3600 aerial photos (1992 for the region north of Tamiami Trail; 1996 for the area south of the Trail) and converted to Arc/Info coverages. The data were ground-truthed by helicopter over-flights and site visits. The coverages were subsequently adjusted to the County's Level II data. This map was prepared for the Army Corps of Engineers.
