**Re: Public Records Act Request**  
Follow-up to Request PR09-306

Dear Ms. Kramer, dear Ms. Nieves:

This is a follow-up to our public records request 09-306. On behalf of the Miccosukee Tribe, we hereby request, pursuant to Chapter 119 of the Florida Statutes, that you additionally provide, for inspection and copying, any documents responsive to the original request, but current through the date you respond to this additional request. We are not seeking duplicate copies, but documents that were not provided in response to the original request PR09-306.

The scope of our original request was as follows:

The Tribe seeks public records in the form of aerial photographs of the Everglades Agricultural Area ("EAA") Reservoir, Phase 1 Project, or any part thereof. Such photos may be in the possession of the public relations, media, construction, ACCELER 8, or Everglades Restoration departments. Staff persons who may have access to such documents or photos include Ken Ammon and Tommy Strowd.


The Tribe also seeks documents related to the termination of the contract for the EAA Reservoir Phase 1, and those documents that show the amount of the termination fee paid to the contractor. The Tribe also seeks documents concerning the termination and/or suspension of the Project Implementation Report ("PIR") on the EAA Reservoir Project. The request encompasses records from the period of time beginning on or about January 2008 and continues through today, except for aerial photographs of the EAA Reservoir Phase 1, which encompasses the period from commencement of construction or construction preparatory activities for the Project through today.

We request that you provide us with information with regard to anticipated costs as soon as

possible and prior to production or reproduction. We ask that the photos and documents that we have requested be provided to us in an electronic format (or the web address be provided) to help facilitate the release of this public information, as envisioned under the Public Records Act.
