Whereas, the Seminole Tribe of Florida has worked together with the District for the protection of the environment and natural resources for the well-being of all of Florida and by these efforts has demonstrated shared values in the management and protection of natural resources while maintaining sovereignty and Tribal right of self-determination;

Whereas, the Seminole Tribe of Florida and the District have developed a model partnering relationship that can be utilized in other areas of the country, as evidenced by numerous successes, including:

Execution of more than 25 Work Plans and numerous amendments

Development of the Wetland Criteria Manual

Development of a Right of Way Agreement

Construction and Operation of STWMD water resource projects on Tribal land

Development of water supply plans, permits and shortages; and
