2. Applications of Heightened Public Concern Pending Final Action

Application 110712-7 Polk County Southeast Wellfield

Public Comment: Jane Graham representing the Audubon of Florida inquired regarding the determination of the permit duration and the District's interaction with South West Florida Water Management District regarding this application.

Staff responded that the District is currently working with the South West Florida Water Management District on this project and is working to develop the proposed interagency action.

Application 090107-1 Crosstown Parkway Extension (Bridge over North Fork)

Application 130918-10 Highlands Dunes

Public Comment: Drew Martin representing the Sierra Club expressed opposition to this application and commented regarding wetland impacts and water drainage.

Application 131113-2 Lantern Walk

Public Comment: Rosa Durando inquired regarding the location of this application.

Staff responded that this project is located in Royal Palm Beach.

Application 131016-10 OS Dressage

Public Comment: Rosa Durando requested to be added to the permit distribution list and expressed concern regarding best management practices.

Staff responded that the Village of Wellington has ordinances regarding best management practices.

Public Comment: Alan Ballweg commented regarding the recent purchase of the Callery Judge Grove and the water supply for this area.
