On September 23, 2008, the Governing Board of the South Florida Water Management District (District) adopted its budget for Fiscal Year 2009. The approved budget allows the District to inject more revenues back into turn-dirt projects that directly improve water quality, develop water supplies, enhance the environment, provide flood protection and expand services. The budget furthers Governor Crist's statewide effort to alleviate budget shortfalls and stimulate economic development in the communities we serve.

Specifically, the approved budget includes \$2 million for capital projects benefiting water resources in Hendry County, Glades County, and the Tri-Cities of western Palm Beach County. Eligible projects must protect public health or the environment, implement a state or local plan for water quality improvement and water restoration, and benefit a District priority waterbody such as Lake Okeechobee, the Everglades, or the Caloosahatchee and St. Lucie rivers.

Special consideration will be given to projects that improve infrastructure and are currently permitted or ready for construction. Proposals will be submitted to our Governing Board for approval in November. In the next few weeks, District staff will be contacting you in order to work together in identifying potential projects for funding.
