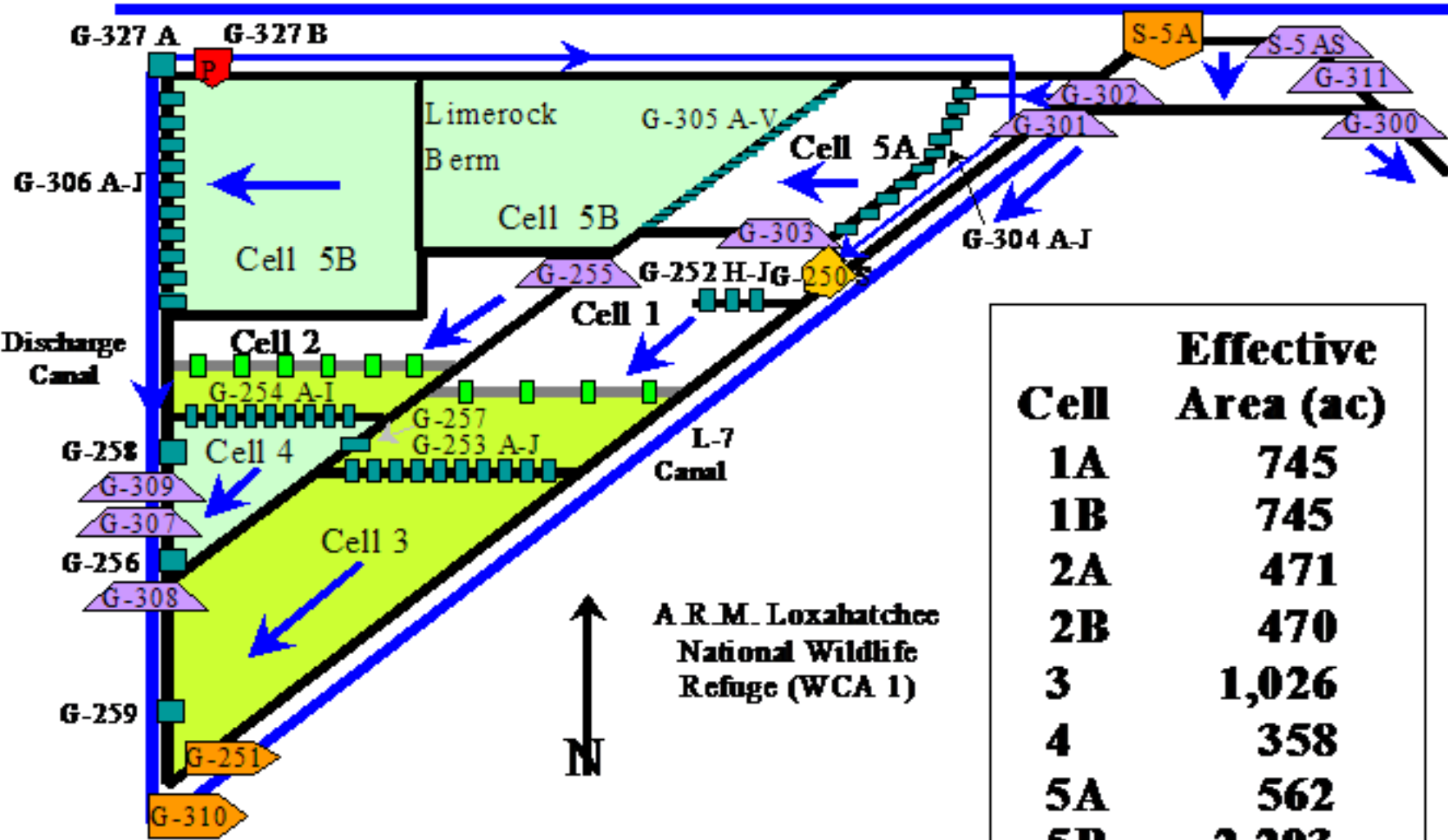

Hi Frank,
As a follow-up to our phone call today about discontinuing monitoring and not installing new monitoring equipment at the G-253s, we would like to request approval for a Minor Revision to the Long-Term Plan for

this change.

When the Long-Term Plan was developed, the monitoring at this levee (actually at 2 of the G-253 culverts - see map below or see attached file) was shown to continue even after the new Cell 1 levee was complete. The internal culvert monitoring that is in Part 8 of the Long-Term Plan is under "Operational Monitoring - BC05", and the specific monitoring locations are shown on Page 8-9 in Table 8.7. It is proposed that with the new levee monitoring information, we will have sufficient information about this flow-way without needing to continue the G-253 monitoring. For this reason, it is proposed that this revision will not have significant impact on scope or schedule. It is also proposed that this revision will not have significant cost impacts (approximate savings of \$80,000 per year).
