

SOUTH FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT Veterans' Preference Claim

Instructions: Complete ONLY if you are claiming Veterans' Preference. All applicants claiming Veterans' Preference must complete this form and include a copy of your DD214, Certificate of Discharge or Separation from Active Duty, or equivalent certification which is to be submitted at time of application.

Subsection 1.01(14) Florida Statute defines the term Veteran as one who has served in the active military and who is discharged under honorable conditions only, or who later received an upgraded discharge under honorable conditions notwithstanding any action by the Department of Veterans Affairs on individuals discharged or released with other than honorable discharges. To receive benefits as a wartime veteran, a veteran must have served for one day or more during one of the military campaigns cited in Section II.

A complaint must be filed within 21 calendar days of the applicant receiving notice of the hiring decision made by the employing agency or within three calendar months of the date of application is filed with the employer. If no notice is given, it is the responsibility of the preferred applicant to maintain contact with the employer to determine of the position has been filled.
